

Model: picturing a good situation

A MODEL is when you picture a situation *with* the value you are talking about. Whereas an ANTI-MODEL is a picture of a bad situation, a MODEL is a picture of a good situation.

A MODEL says:

This is what things would be like if we had what I'm talking about

Look how great it would be with what I'm talking about

Look at this picture and get more determined to get a good situation, not a bad situation

Take this picture into your heart. Use it to motivate yourself. Let's try to make things more like this picture.

Examples

Here is an example

Imagine a world with education.

With education, people would be able to better themselves.

With education, communities would not have to rely on outsiders to fill key positions.

With education, young people would have hope for themselves and would not take up substance abuse.

Another example

Imagine a world with self-respect.

In a world with self-respect, there would be very little violence and fighting.

In a world with self-respect, there would be no despair and unhappiness.

In a world with self-respect, there would be a sense of hope and a sense of community.
