CONDITIONS

Applicants for the 2010 WAALC scholarship must

- Be an individual financial member – either renew your membership or join WAALC prior to applying.
- Provide original receipts for expenditure incurred for travel, meals or accommodation while attending the conference. The expenses claimed from WAALC must not be reimbursed from any other source.
- Apply before close of business 21st July 2010.

If you are awarded a scholarship, your employer may pay some or all of your costs to attend the conference and invoice WAALC an amount for an amount not exceeding \$500 (GST inclusive) for actual costs you incurred.

- your work in the adult literacy and numeracy field.
